Those currently serving on AIC Boards/Committees may not receive awards during their tenure. Nominations may be re-submitted for three consecutive years.	
HOW TO NOMINATE	
<b>Proposer:</b> Fill out a <b>Nomination Form</b> (please type or print). Include a separate written statement providing evidence of the nominee's commitment to the field in the areas of research, analysis, conservation, teaching and support of the textile conservation community. Send a copy of these instructions to one additional Sponsor you have listed and have the Sponsor return their separate written statement to you. <b>Sponsor:</b> Please send your written statement (please type or print) as a PDF document, providing evidence of the nominee's commitment to the field in the areas of research, analysis, conservation, teaching and support of the textile conservation, to the Proposer.	



## Textile Specialty Group Achievement Award

### Purpose

For outstanding contributions to the field of textile conservation by an individual or entity that has promoted, defended and worked in support of the importance of textiles and their need for preservation.

### Criteria

Nominations must meet the following criteria:

Individual nominees should be or have been a Professional Associate or a Fellow of the American Institute for the Conservation of Historic and Artistic Works. Dedication to the organization over their years of membership will be taken into consideration. Those currently serving on AIC Boards/Committees may not receive awards during their tenure.

Note: Nominations may be resubmitted for three years running.

### How to Nominate

1. The **Proposer** (formerly called Nominator) must be an Associate, a Professional Associate or a Fellow of the American Institute for the Conservation of Historic and Artistic Works. The **Proposer** completes the Nomination Form and also provides a written evidence of the nominee's commitment to the field in areas such as research, analysis, conservation, teaching, and support of the textile conservation community.
2. The **Proposer** also sends a copy of the the Nomination Form to a **Sponsor** and has that **Sponsor** return their separate written statement (providing evidence of the nominee's commitment to the field in areas such as research, analysis, conservation, teaching, and support of the textile conservation community) to the **Proposer** in a PDF format.
3. The **Sponsor** must be an Associate, a Professional Associate or a Fellow of the American Institute for the Conservation of Historic and Artistic Works.
4. The **Proposer** submits the completed Nomination Form with the two separate written statements (all 3 in PDF format) to Ruth Seyler via email at [rseyler@conservation-us.org](mailto:rseyler@conservation-us.org) (in the email Subject line: 2015 TSG Achievement Award Nomination: *Name of Nominee*) by **January 15**. An email confirmation of receipt will be sent to Proposers.
