Dr. Laurie Richardson, Florida International University, conducts research into coral diseases using microbiology and molecular techniques to track pathogens on reefs. Her field

research includes surveying, monitoring, and tracking of disease outbreaks in corals. In particular, she has been tracking both short-term and long-term effects of black band disease and white plague in corals. Her primary research site is the Florida Keys, where she has worked since 1990. Dr. Richardson's ground breaking research has been published in such prestigious journals as *Nature*, *Trends in Ecology and Evolution*, and *Coral Reefs*.
